

# **Strategies for Analyzing PROGRESS Center IEP Tip Sheets**



## **About the Activity**

The following activity is intended to help you gain a deeper understanding of the required components of the individualized education program (IEP) under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). The activity uses the PROGRESS Center IEP Tip Sheet Series to introduce the IDEA language, provide tips for implementation, and share resources for the required IEP components. This activity includes time for individual, peer, and group reflection and discussion.

### **Objectives**

At the conclusion of this activity, you will be able to

- explain the IDEA requirements for an IEP component,
- identify tips for implementing an IEP component, and
- access additional resources related to an IEP component.

#### **Materials**

You will need the following:

- Copy of the selected <u>IEP</u>
   <u>Tip Sheet</u>
- Highlighter/pen
- Sticky notes (optional)

#### **Directions**

The activity includes three primary steps that encourage you to review the content covered in the tip sheet independently, as a small group, and as a whole group. Throughout the activity note any questions or reflections that you have using sticky notes or in the column provided.

Step	Directions	Reflections and notes
Step 1: Independent reflection	<ul> <li>Individually review the IDEA definition outlined on the top of the tip sheet.</li> <li>Highlight or underline what stands out to you in the definition.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Note takeaways and reflections using sticky notes or in the column provided.</li> </ul>	
Step 2: Small group or partner sharing	<ul> <li>Turn to a partner or form a small group.</li> <li>Share what stood out to you while reviewing the IDEA definition on the tip sheet.</li> <li>Note any outstanding questions you have.</li> </ul>	
Step 3: Whole- group discussion and reflection	Share reflections, takeaways, and questions with the full group.

Define the IEP component for a new colleague or a parent.
